





ART REQUIRES REAL OF STREET

BY HEIDI HODGES

SEVERAL YEARS AGO, someone had an interesting question for me. "Where do you do your writing?" she asked, saying she pictured me sitting on a dock, pencil and notebook in hand, enjoying a beautiful day.

Caught off guard, I laughed a little and said "Actually, I write on a computer, at a desk. There's usually a pile of paperwork next to me, and a sink full of dishes waiting to get done."

Maybe I should have lied because she was sorely disappointed.

But that's the reality. I wager it's probably a similar story for most artists.

Art is inspired by so many things, including the beauty of an area. Indeed, Door and Kewaunee counties do a bang up job in that department, with their expansive shorelines, forests, hills, creeks, and meadows. Not to mention support from peers and contagious energy from all the other arts.

But the hard work of creating art is different from inspiration. It's in the trenches. It happens in studios, basements, and porches. It means throwing clay pots in the laundry room, like our cover artist did in her early days. It happens during the bustle of summer, and in the lonely dark of winter. It happens with the demands of life happening at the same time.

It's messy. It's "roll up the sleeves" kind of work, even if it's just typing on a computer, because if you dedicate your life to it, it has to get done. Even if the dishes must wait.

True, a studio space may be located in a picturesque location, but no matter where the art gets created, it takes work.

Maybe that notion seems romantic, but there's something else you should know: Creative work takes courage. I'm talking real braveru.

Let's start at the beginning, when our storied artists from the 60s and 70s first came to the area. Many left good jobs in big cities, uprooting families, to pursue a life in art. In that blossoming, creative heyday, the area was busy building an artistic reputation. Still, there were no guarantees that a living could be made here.

I would argue that today, the stakes are even higher. There's far less financial wiggle room, and a lot more competition from all aspects of tourism.

For artists these days, there's a lot of burning the candle at both ends to make it work. I can attest that there's not a lot of "sitting on a dock, letting inspiration wash over you" time.


To compound issues, the area comes with dramatic seasonal ups and downs. It takes careful planning and budgeting if it's going to work. So, a life in the arts takes more than creative skills, it takes business savvy, too.

Then, after all that, artists must learn what sells and what doesn't. Sometimes, the creative work that sustains an artist's soul gets buried beneath art that sustains the bottom line. Practically all creative people I've interviewed over the years have shown me their personal, sometimes experimental work which is often in stark contrast to their "for sale" work.

Of course, everyone makes compromises in life. But it's more fraught when you are making a living in the arts because it is objectively more than a job. It's deeply personal. Artists put their heart on the shelf with a price tag, hoping someone else will love it enough to buy it. It's a complicated relationship.

And that's where bravery comes in. Creating art is one thing.

Offering it to others takes real courage.



OFF THE WHEEL POTTERY

Some kids grow up knowing they are destined to be artists. Every choice in life moves them toward that goal. But others meander a bit, and when they find their path, it's an awakening.

2024 cover artist Renee Schwaller took the meandering route. In fact, it was a chance encounter that changed everything, a dance class with Ginka Cohn, who was married to clay artist Abe Cohn.

"If I had never taken that dance class with Ginka Cohn, I wouldn't be a potter," she recalled

MEANDERING TOWARDS A MISSION

While it wasn't a straight path for Renee, there were inklings along the way.

The journey began while finishing her major in communications at UW Milwaukee. The Little Chute native spent summers working in Door County, waiting tables at the Cookery in Fish Creek, and becoming familiar with the area.

After her undergrad years, she took some time to explore out west a bit. She spent a summer living in Glacial National Park, working at a restaurant and hiking in the back country. After

that, she spent two winters in Colorado where she snowboarded and waited tables to make ends meet.

All the while Renee had an interest in the arts, but hadn't pursued it seriously at that point.

After Colorado, she came back to Door County. While doing her regular restaurant work. she decided to take a dance class offered by Ginka Cohn. Ginka and her husband Abe were well-known artists in Northern Door and beyond.

During the class, "She found out I was an artist. Of some sort." said Renee. "Although I'd never done pottery." When Ginka learned of Renee's interest, she invited her to work at their gallery doing retail. During that summer, Renee absorbed the couple's artistic ethos.

That experience opened the door to the idea of art as a career. and it introduced her to other local artists. But more than that, it brought her up close with clay, something that truly compelled her. "I touched pottery," she said. It left a deep impression.

And she had an epiphany: "Being around pottery made me realize 'Wow, I can do two dimensional art on three dimensional work."

The experience inspired her to go back to school, this time to the University of Minnesota, where she focused on art. It was there she met her future husband. Steve. (Today, Steve is an accountant at Door County Medical Center in Sturgeon Bay.)

In a fun turn of events, while she was at U of M, she participated in an exchange program and spent a semester in Hawaii, along with Steve, studying art.

After having worked at The Potter's Wheel with Abe and Ginka, and also with leather artist Mary Ellen Sisulak, in a gallery she had in Egg Harbor at the time, and also at her studio in Ellison Bay, Renee learned the business end of the art world. And she realized she wanted to open her own gallery.

It was artist Margaret Lockwood, herself the Door Kewaunee Arts Guidebook cover artist in 2021, who gave Renee the biggest push to pursue her dream.

It was a simple question that stuck with Renee: "What do you really want to do?" Lockwood asked the young artist. When Renee said she wanted to open her own gallery, Lockwood responded "Well, then. do it!"

With that echoing in her mind, she set out on a mission.

OFF THE WHEEL

After Renee and Steve moved back to Door County, they stayed with Renee's parents in Fish Creek while seeking a place of their own. When they found an 1890s farmhouse and barn on County E in Egg Harbor they knew they had landed on the perfect place. But there was a lot of work to be done.

Everything happened all at once. They purchased the property in '96, got married in the yard in '97 and opened the gallery, Off the Wheel Pottery, in '98. In 1999, they had their first child, Ava. "We were moving, getting married, remodeling, starting the business, and having kids all at the same time," she said, with a characteristic infectious laugh.

During those early years, she threw pots in the laundry room of the house, "and schlepped them to the gallery" until she was able to build a separate studio space.

The outbuildings—the granary and barn-were eventually remodeled with the help of Renee's

parents and Steve and repurposed for the business. In 2010, they opened the barn as a gallery space. "I couldn't have done any of this without their help and support," she said.

Schwaller added the works of other artists, understanding the business end of studio and gallery. And she continued with her own work.

The next couple of years, the business grew, and son Wyatt came along in 2004. Working while the kids napped, Schwaller quickly found her signature style of drawing on pots, which included her well-recognized bird form, a motif she continues to use today.

But, she says, "the world of clay is so

huge," and she doesn't want to be pigeon-holed into one style or form. She explained that she is drawn to experimenting, especially now that the kids are adults, and she has a little more available time. "I'd get bored doing the same things," she said.

"I usually work spontaneously. I don't like things to be super planned. I'm more like 'what am I going to do today?'"

But with Renee's style of decorating her pieces, she does have a routine for her studio. "With clay, you have to work with it at a certain dryness: putting handles on, decorating, carving. Maybe I'll do a run of mugs. A couple pitchers. Put them under plastic. Then the next day, if they are dry enough, I'll put handles on."

But, she admits, "I don't work very efficiently. I'll just do random stuff," she said with a laugh. "I usually don't know what I'm going to paint on the pot until I set it in front of me. It's like 'What do you want to be?'"

Her creative process is part inspiration, part experience, she explained. Like knowing which colors she likes to use and what works best.

While she understands that customers are drawn to her signature style, "I don't do production work," she said. "I work spontaneously. Maybe I make a mug, and it's whatever shape it wants to be. You can make a cup because you want something to drink out of or you can make a sculpture with a deeper meaning...I like to do both."

The business grew steadily over the years, and even survived the COVID years. "The pandemic year was busy, actually," she said. "Then the next two years were (exceptionally) busy. I didn't expect it; it was a bit too much. Now, it's back to normal."

"Normal" means being open six days a week May through October (and, as the website says, "closed on Sundays for sanity") and working on inventory and business during the off season.

In her sparce free time, mostly during the off season, she enjoys experimenting with new ideas and techniques. She described a recent undertaking, working with a fellow potter who has a woodfired kiln. She took an overnight shift, tending the kiln. "We did two firings. We're learning. But it turned out really cool," she said. "We'll make it better and better every time we fire the kiln."

THE NEW AND THE OLD

Over the years, Schwaller has taught pottery classes, but with the demands on her time now, she has stepped back. "I loved teaching," she said, especially since pottery instruction is not as prevalent as it used to be. "But I just don't have the time."

Yet, she is still helping inspire and mentor the next generation, working with five different interns in recent years. Some have gone on to careers in the arts and pottery. And her own children, Ava and Wyatt, have a penchant for arts as well.

In a lovely "full circle" story, today Renee works on her own mentor Abe Cohn's wheel. Abe died in 2013, two

years after his wife Ginka. Friends and family of the couple worked to get Abe's items to other local potters, and Renee was the recipient of one of the esteemed potter's wheels.

Because the Cohn's home, studio and gallery were razed after their death, Renee salvaged shelves for her studio, and doors for inside their home. "It (the razing) was really sad when it happened," she recalled. "I loved that place."

A decade later, and those items are a reminder of her mentors. Thinking back on the series of events that fell in place for her to be a potter and gallery owner today, she said, "I think it's pretty wild and pretty cool how it all played out. I love how life can change in an instant, or because of one relationship. I'm very grateful for what happened."

The wheel resides in Renee's studio, part of the gallery complex at Off the

Wheel. The buildings and grounds are a place for business and an outlet for her creativity. But it's much more than that.

The entire grounds are pastoral, filled with wildflowers and pottery. It's the kind of place where visitors might be inspired to linger a bit, and she welcomes it. "The setting is a big part of it," she said, describing the gallery location. "People can hang out as much as they want. And I love being able to share the barn with people."

The 1890s barn is a historic timber frame structure, with hand-hewn beams. "It's pretty unique," she said. "We are lucky we can keep it up and can put money into it because it's a business."

And they've invested in the property around the gallery, too. "We planted gobs of stuff. And we've been remodeling for 27 years."

WHAT'S NEXT

Like most artists here, she has no plans to retire, but can envision cutting back a bit at some point. "But I'll probably do pots forever," she said.

That's because she feels she's only scratched the surface of the pottery world. Experimenting with the wood-fired kiln is one avenue. She also "makes work on the slab roller and an extruder, too," she said. And there are different combinations of "building and throwing. You can make anything out of clay. It's pretty wild," she said, drifting off in thought a bit, thinking of the next thing she wants to try.

"There's even different clay for different techniques...I guess I am really doing a lot of different things."

Beyond the clay is the decoration she applies, from the art she carves to the glazes she uses, much of which she mixes herself.

And, during the off season, she takes classes herself. "Every vear I take a class somewhere." she said. One of her favorites is in Dodgeville, Wis. "It's like art camp for grownups," she said. She's also taken classes at The Clearing in Ellison Bay, and other places, keeping up with the vast world of clay.

"My work is about the earth, nature, comfort, function, and beauty," she said. "I love the medium. It's picky and complicated. And it is practical and diverse, like a metaphor for life."

Jean Berkenstock, Midsummer's Music co-founder, died Oct. 3 at the age of 89. A world-class flutist, Jean was actively performing until about eight years

Well-known locally as the co-founder of Midsummer's Music, along with husband Jim, she was instrumental in bringing high-end chamber music to Door County audiences for more than three decades. Midsummer's Music Festival started humbly in 1991 as a one-week, five-concert event. In 2023, the season saw 42 concerts in the summer and early autumn.

Jean's accomplishments and accolades are many, including a television appearance when she was a teenager, and performing with prestigious orchestras, such as Lyric Opera of Chicago, Atlanta Symphony, Grant Park Symphony Orchestra, and others. In 1989 she was named principal flute of the Chicago Philharmonic, a position she held until 2012.

Jean is survived by her husband Jim, and children and grandchildren.


Champeau died Dec. 1, 2023, at the age of 97.


